Young Surveyor of the Year

In order to recognize the achievements and merits of its members, the Wisconsin Society of Land Surveyors has created an award to be given to the **Young Surveyor of the Year** as nominated by his/her peers.

The award shall be given at the Annual Institute to the “Young Surveyor of the Year” candidate who has been selected in accordance with the following guidelines.

1. Shall be a member of the Wisconsin Society of Land Surveyors in good standing for a minimum of 3 consecutive years.
2. Shall be nominated by any WSLs member.
3. Candidate shall be under the age of 35 as of the date of nomination.
4. Candidate shall be either a Professional Land Surveyor, a Certified Survey Technician, or have been an associate or student member for a minimum of 3 consecutive years.
5. The WSLs member nominating the candidate shall submit a description of the candidate and his/her qualifications, not to exceed one page, to the WSLs Executive Director by November 1st.
6. The selection committee shall consist of the WSLs Outreach Committee.
7. Board members shall not be eligible for Young Surveyor of the Year unless they have served as a board member 3 or more consecutive years.
8. A candidate selected as “Young Surveyor of the Year” shall not be eligible for the award more than once.
9. Amendments to these requirements shall be made by the WSLs Board of Directors or their assigns, and be approved the WSLs Board of Directors.
10. Only one award shall be given per year
